

4. PERSONAL APPERANCE

- 4.1. General (For all students)
 - 4.1.1. All students must be well-groomed, tidy and presentable in their personal appearance.
 - 4.1.2. Finger nails should be kept short. The distal edge of the nails (white part of nails extending beyond the flesh) is to be less than a millimeter in length.
 - 4.1.2.1. Students who play musical instruments which require slightly longer nails are to obtain written permission from the Headmaster/Headmistress. by submitting a letter from their parents. An exemption card issued by the VP of Student Affairs must be kept by the student and produced when required.
 - 4.1.2.2. Students are not allowed to have their nails polished.
 - 4.1.2.3. Students are not allowed to wear amulets, or religious ornaments, strings (for religious reasons) or sports accessories to the school unless they have a letter from parents. Only kara bangles worn by Sikhs are allowed (Ref: Surat Perkeliling Iktisas Bil 3 tahun 2011).
 - 4.1.3. Henna (inai) are allowed but tattoos or any form of skin arts is strictly prohibited.
 - 4.1.4. Wearing of any form of jewellery including ear stude is strictly prohibited.
- 4.2. Boys Appearance

Boys's hair must be well trimmed hair and must not exceed the shoulder.

- 4.2.1. Beard are allowed but need to keep it neatly but the moustaches are not allowed.
- 4.2.2. Wearing of any form of jewellery including ear stude is strictly prohibited.

5. ASSEMBLY

- 5.1. All students are expected to be present at all school assemblies, unless prior written permission has been obtained from the Headmaster/Headmistress. If assembly is cancelled, all students are to be in their homeroom and not loiter around.
- 5.2. Respectful silence and order must be maintained during assemblies and formal



gatherings.

- 5.3. Students are required to sing the National Anthem, and Asmaul Husna.
- 5.4. Students are encouraged to bring reading materials (which are permitted by school) to read while waiting for assembly to begin.
- 5.5. Sleeves of long-sleeved shirt must be rolled down during assemblies and special assemblies.
- 5.6. On Monday and special occasions, and when representing the school, students are required to wear the prescribed school Monday's attire.
 - 5.6.1. The tie is to be knotted up properly and the collar buttoned up to ensure a smart appearance throughout the day.
 - 5.6.2. Students who fail to wear the school Monday's attire on Monday or special occasions will be fined RM10 per item.
